### *Defense National Stockpile Center* **ANNOUNCES AVAILABILITY OF THE** Final Mercury Management Environmental Impact Statement

The **Defense National Stockpile Center (DNSC)** announces the availability of the *Final Mercury Management Environmental Impact Statement (Final EIS)*. The Final EIS analyzes three alternatives for managing DNSC's excess mercury: 1) consolidated storage of the mercury at one site, 2) sale of the stockpile and 3) no-action, i.e., leave the mercury at current storage locations. DNSC's preferred alternative is consolidated storage at one site. The Final EIS also presents public comments on the Draft EIS and DNSC responses.
