Defense National Stockpile Center **ANNOUNCES AVAILABILITY OF THE** Final Mercury Management Environmental Impact Statement

The Defense National Stockpile Center (DNSC) announces the availability of the *Final Mercury Management Environmental Impact Statement* (Final EIS). The Final EIS analyzes three alternatives for managing DNSC's excess mercury: 1) consolidated storage of the mercury at one site, 2) sale of the stockpile and 3) no-action, i.e., leave the mercury at current storage locations. DNSC's preferred alternative is consolidated storage at one site. The Pez Lake Development, which is analyzed in the EIS as one of the sites representing a range of environmental and socioeconomic settings, is no longer under consideration as a consolidated storage site. The Advantage Group, which manages the site, withdrew it from consideration based on business development plans. The Final EIS also presents public comments on the Draft EIS and DNSC responses.
